

Strikingly editor drawbacks (feedback)

Styling

- Limited to one button style and colour for the entire website (Figure 1). Would be nice to create at least two styles, like filled and outlined.

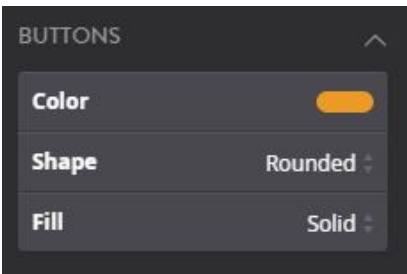

- Heading styling does not apply to standalone textboxes (Figure 2), but rather only to presets, like card-like elements (Figure 3).

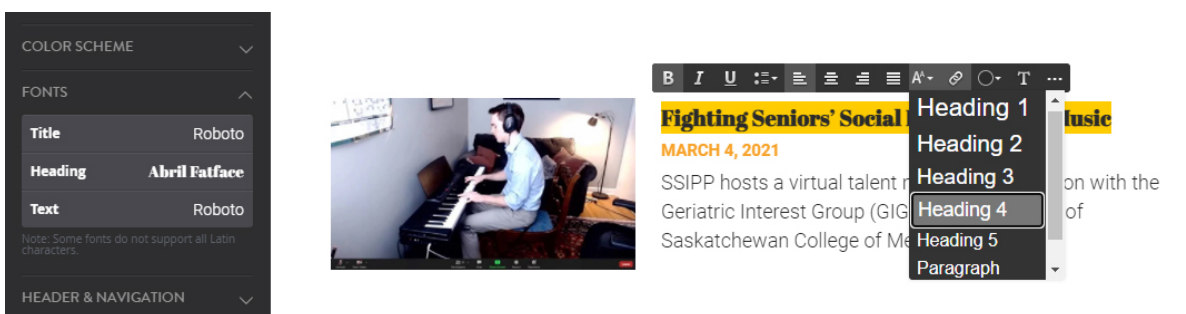

- Default footer only has preset textbox elements, with no control over the order or colours of social media icons (Figure 4); had to create a custom section for greater control and add elements like inquiry fields (as seen on website).

- No option to remove underlines for linked text (Figure 5); requested devs to manually remove underlines for links like news articles

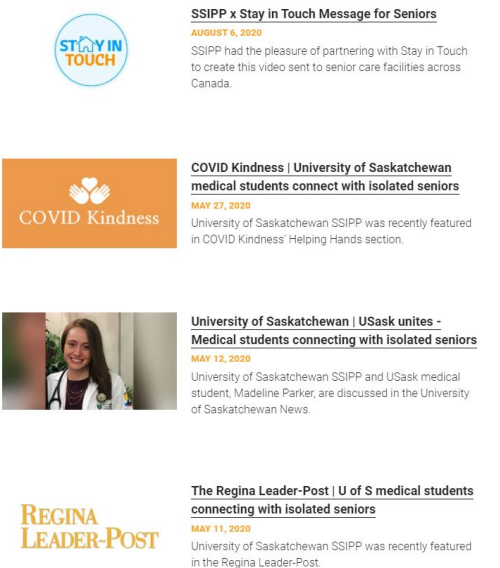

Layout

- Editing the website's mobile version also affects the desktop version; text does not scale between devices (Figure 6)
- No option to copy and paste site elements
- No option to add buttons to cards/card-like elements
- No option for user to 'load more'; all list items are forced to be visible, which makes a page longer than ideal

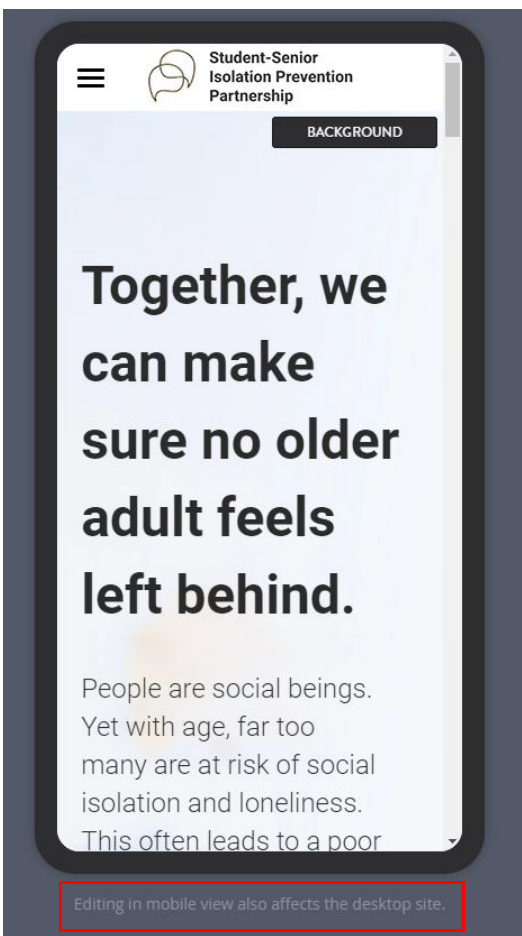

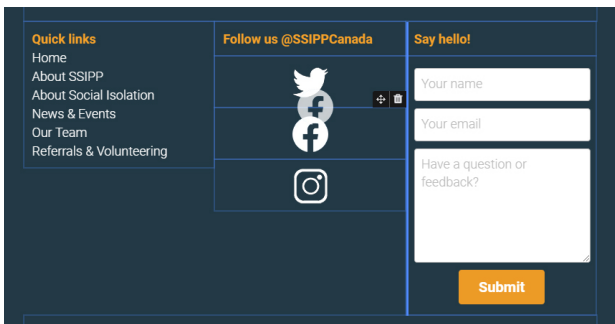

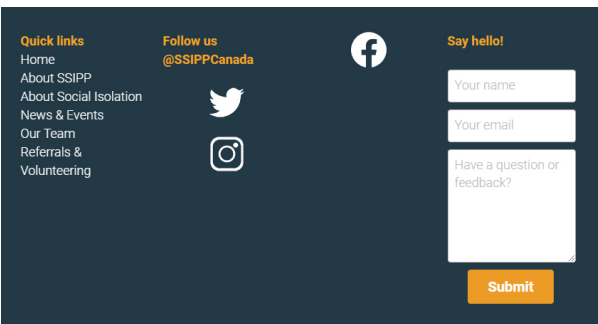
